Sanctuary Point is but one town in the Bay & Basin, albeit with a population of over 6,500, it is not probably the centre of the Bay & Basin and with the massive construction work, that is going on in Vincentia with the soon to be built Woolworths Vincentia Shopping Centre and the expanding Bayswood Development also in Vincentia, perhaps the Vincentia area could be an ideal location for a new Police Station and a more central area with the potential of a much increased population from Commercial and Residential development in the near future!

I have heard all these shallow statements that say “We don’t need new Police Stations, because Police Stations don’t stop crime and it is more Police on the beat that stops crime.” ... So where do you think more Police are going to work from... POLICE STATIONS and that’s what we need in the central Shoalhaven to stop the crime here and relieve the overflow of response from Nowra, so they can concentrate on the Nowra area...

We all know that the Bay & Basin is over 30 km from NOWRA! And a response from Nowra can take hours, I believe a 24/7 Police Station in the Bay & Basin is “Time Now” and I would respectfully ask the Commissioner of Police to consider our situation on the basis of an expanding population in the Bay & Basin of the Shoalhaven and take advantage of the promise made by the Baird Government to build a new Police Station in the Central Shoalhaven, if re elected for another term in 2015... They have been re elected! And “Now,” perhaps now could be a good time to take advantage of that promise! Not only for the communities, who the Police serve, but! Also for the Police, who are appreciated by our communities!

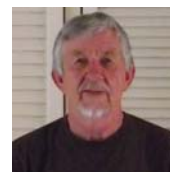

Fig 1 shows the placement where the main road into the Car Park will be constructed. Fig 2 is the position where the number 1 car park will be built.

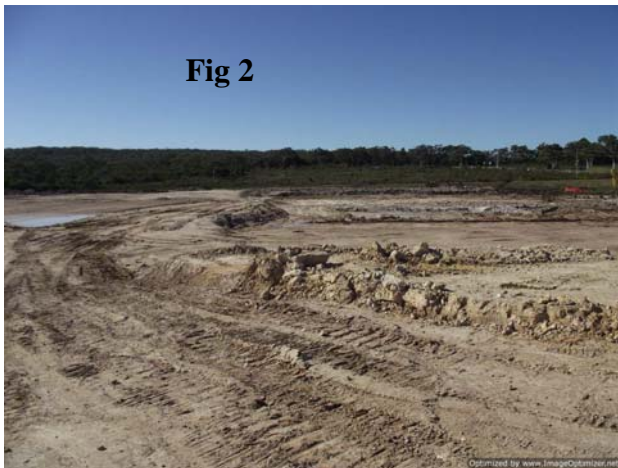

From On the Beat – NSW Police Crime Prevention



Do not Drink and Drive.

I am back from leave, I suppose you have all been waiting with baited breath to see what information my next literary masterpiece will contain. Well, wait no longer.

Easter is coming up very quickly and it is a time of celebration. The problem is that some people celebrate a little too much and their behavior at Pubs and Clubs come into question. Over Easter the Licensing Police will be enforcing licensing conditions in the Pubs and Clubs and Bottle Shops within the Shoalhaven. Police will also be patrolling the CBD, parks, boat ramps and other areas where intoxicated persons may frequent. Let it be known that if you play up in a Club, Pub or out in Public, your actions have consequences and you may find that your Easter present may be given to you by the Local Magistrate and not the Easter Bunny, and it won't be made of chocolate. To refresh your memory if you plan to hit the grog down the local pub or Club, here is some sobering information.

Section 77 of the Liquor Act, 2007 (Translated into normal English) states; Staff or Police can refuse admission to a licensed premises, or ask you to leave the premises if you are intoxicated, violent, quarrelsome or disorderly, smoke in a non smoking area, possess or use prohibited drugs or if your presence on the premises renders the licensee liable to a penalty under the Act.

If you have been refused admission or asked to leave, then you have to leave the area immediately, do not stay at the location and argue the point as further sanctions may ensue. You could be issued with a Penalty Notice to the value of \$550 or end up in Court facing a possible \$5500 fine.

If you refuse to comply a reasonable degree of force as may be necessary may be used to turn a person out of licensed premises. You must stay beyond a 50 metre peripheral Boundary away from the premises.

A person who has been refused admission to, or turned out of, licensed premises in accordance with this section must not re-enter or attempt to re-enter the premises within 24 hours of being refused admission or being turned out. Again, failing to comply is also a \$550 Penalty notice or face a possible \$5500 fine at Court.

To recap, be responsible when you have a drink at Easter. Don't play up or you may find yourself facing the Magistrate in the Nowra local Court which is the opposite to fun.

Do not Drink and Drive.
