



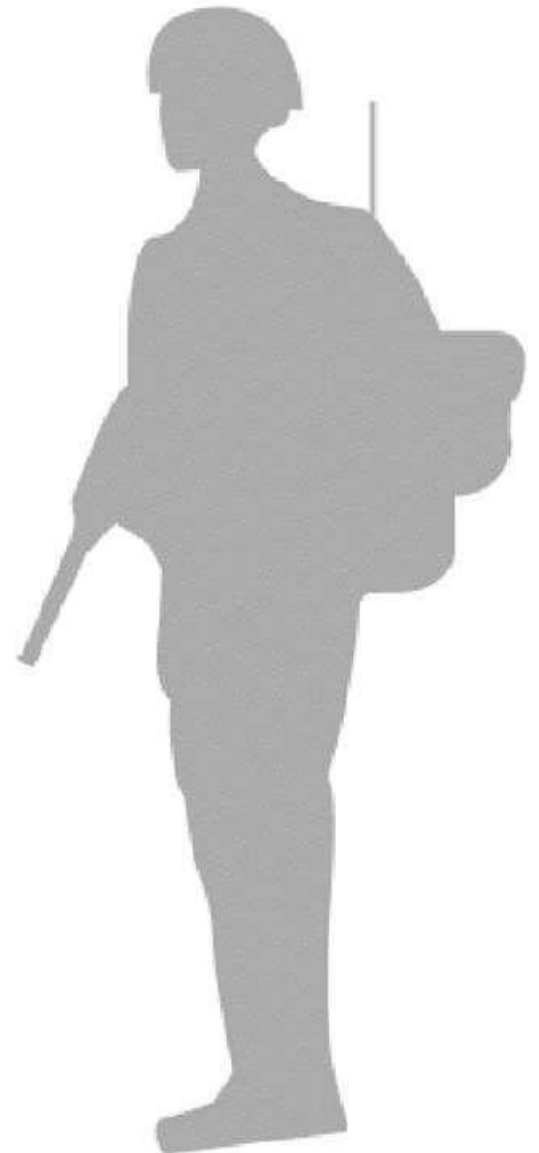

Independent Candidate Grant Schultz Welcomes Princes Highway Funding

Independent Candidate for Gilmore Grant Schultz has welcomed the NSW State Governments announcement of a \$960 million dollar upgrade of the Princes highway, including plans to duplicate the highway from Jervis Bay turnoff to Sussex Inlet Road.

He also welcomes the State Government commitment to commence planning for duplication of the Princes Highway to the Victorian border including planning of;

- A Moruya Bypass; and
- Planning work for the Milton and Ulladulla Bypass and upgrades for the Princes Highway from Burrill Lake to Batemans Bay

"This is a great start – but I'd like to see a commitment to funding the work by the Federal Government".

"The State Government has really come to the party on this but we need an 80/20 funding commitment so once the plans are done we can commence the work."

Mr Schultz went on to say "As a former police officer, and travelling on this road every day, I am only too aware of the dangers it represents. We have a massive amount of tourists travelling to our region, and without public transport this highway is all they have".

"This issue is above politics, and I call on all parties and their candidates, to immediately commit to this infrastructure project".

The South Coast has been ignored by the Federal Government for far too long and now is the time to act.

I can thankfully praise Council for the rectification of the One hand Rail Steps from Red Head Point, for including the second rail and a couple of new steps from the property of the "By The Beach B&B," towards the top side of the steep steps and making the steps that much safer for all who use them.



I thank you for what you have done... Although the overall construction is very amateurish and I will try avoid using the steps! Unless I have too!

Under the right management of this neglected asset, the Ray Brooks Reserve, Sanctuary Point, could be developed into a great asset and an **ICONIC Location for Local and Visiting Tourists, to enjoy the wonders of the beautiful waters and landscapes of the St Georges Basin in comfort...**

Next of KIN Program: It time again to give the Next of Kin Program a bit of a plug.

The Next of Kin Program helps people living alone to have the contact details of their nominated person recorded at a local police station.

The contact details of the Next of Kin, as well as the nominated doctor, dentist and any medical alerts that would help in an emergency situation will be entered onto a register. Any information provided will be securely stored and only accessed by NSW Police.

This information may assist the ambulance and police in an emergency situation to contact a relative or other nominated person to inform them of your situation.

We will give you a key ring and a sticker. Your registered number needs to be placed on these. You can carry the key ring with you at all times. The sticker can be placed on your home phone or fridge to alert emergency services that you are registered with the next of kin program.

You can get on the Google and look up the NSW Police website for more info on the NOK Program or alternatively you can contact your local police station and ask to speak with the Crime Prevention Officer about the Next of Kin Program and application process. **The Next of Kin Program is a FREE of charge service.**

PACC Meeting: Are you Aboriginal and are you interested to help police and the Aboriginal community address problems within the community associated with crime, crime prevention and community safety.

If you said yes to both of these questions, why don't you come along the next Police Aboriginal Consultative Committee meeting being held 10:30am on April 4, 2019 at the Cullunghutti Aboriginal Child and Family Centre on Holloway Road, Nowra.

The PACC meetings are a forum that permits both police and Aboriginal people to address problems in the Aboriginal community associated with crime, crime prevention and community safety.

The PACC are not to be used for complaints about police or other government agencies but is there to address the issues of reducing Aboriginal crime rates and community safety issues.

Remember: Do not Drink and Drive and you can Dob in a Druggie any time you like, by contacting Nowra Police or ringing Crime Stoppers.
