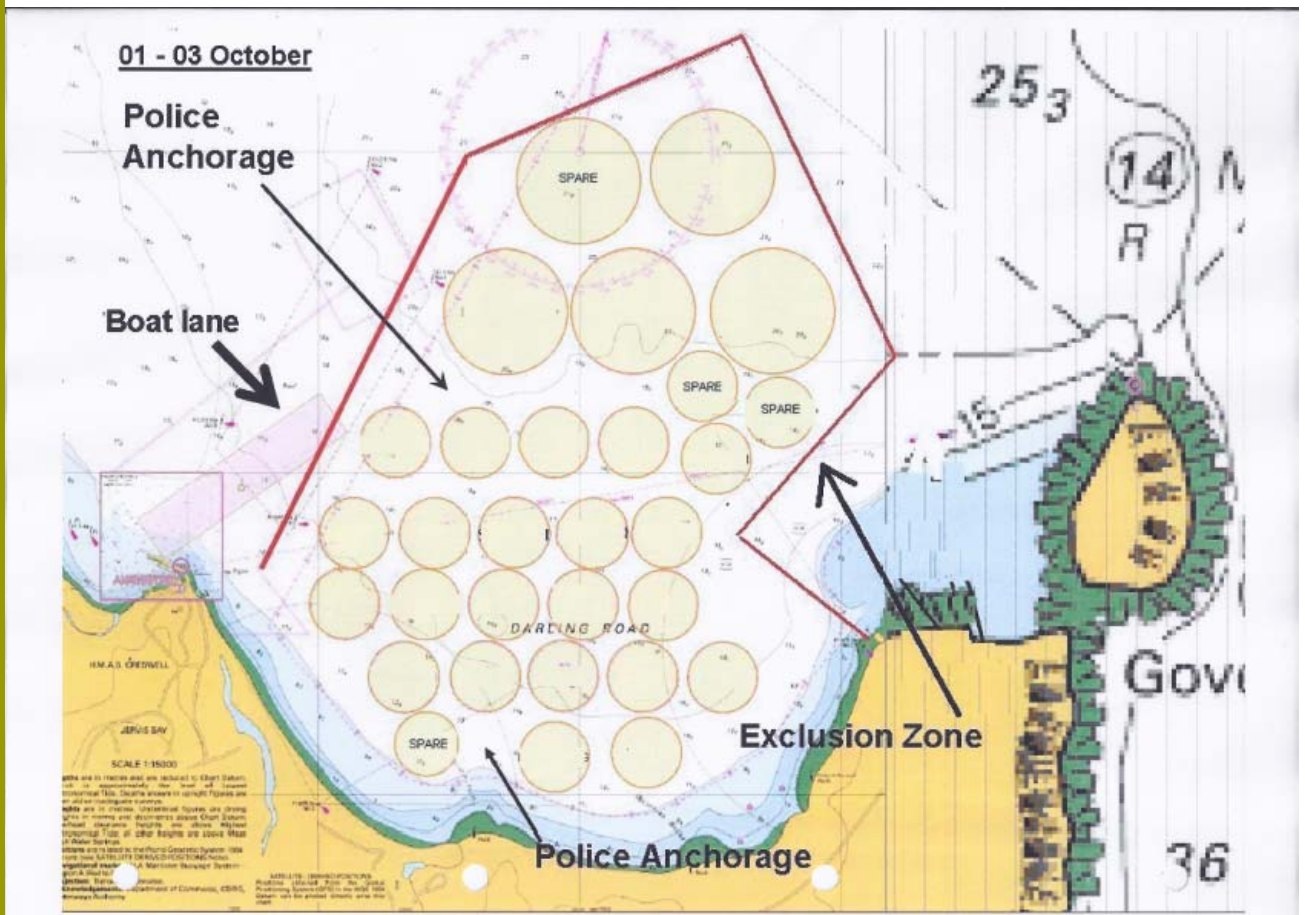
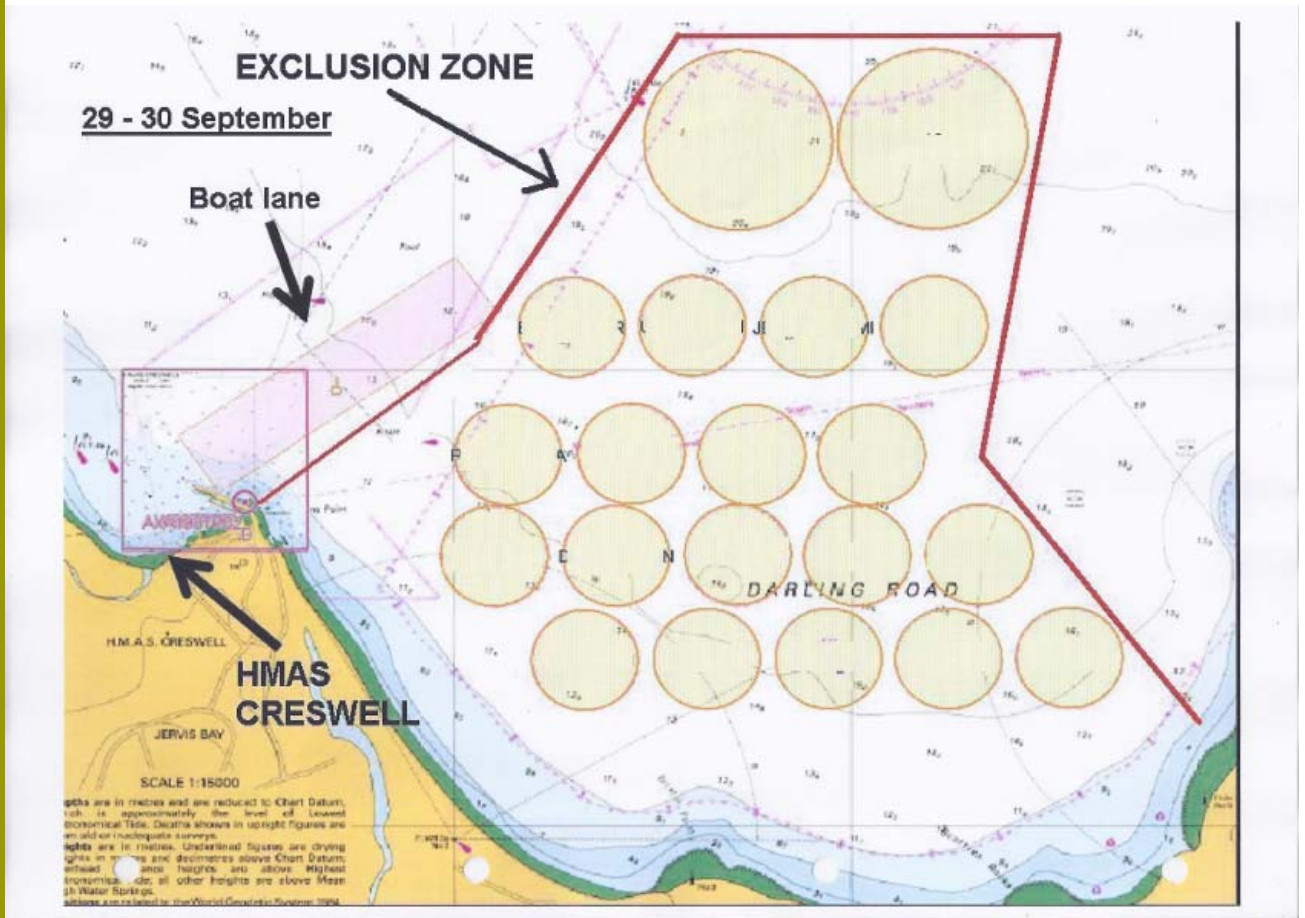

It will also become a Statistic and they can be used for the allocation of Police in your Local Police Precincts.

Remember it will be recorded as an incident in our Town and when allocating resources to an area, priority is usually given to the Areas, where phoned in incidents are recorded... These indicate where hot spots are and need additional resources!

This photo was given to me by a Director of the St Georges Basin Country Club, who was as appalled as myself of such a despicable and callous action by anyone, let alone the probability of someone from amongst our own midst in Sanctuary Point.

On Monday 15th July 2013 this Kangaroo was shot in the jaw, with a metal crossbow bolt and although a local vet attended the Kangaroo, who said the kangaroo would likely survive, the fact remains that someone has gone unpunished for their actions. If you have any information of this incident, please take a note of the following

extract from the NSW Government & Heritage Web Site and make a call to stamp out this senseless behaviour of an irresponsible person or persons amongst us!

National Parks & Wildlife Services (NPWS).

NPWS Regional Manager Diane Garrood said she was dismayed by such an irresponsible and cruel action.

“Our native fauna deserve protection, not senseless, inhumane actions like this,” Ms Garrood said. Anyone with information is asked to contact the NPWS office at Nowra on 4428 6300 or Huskisson police on 4441 5779.

Kangaroos are protected fauna under the *National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974* and harming them carries a maximum penalty of \$11,000 and six months imprisonment.
