*The CFMEU and Management of the mill are united in their campaign to persuade Governments, Business Houses, Printing Shops and Home Printers, to reconsider their choice of paper they purchase and if not already purchasing Australian Made Paper, such as the Security Paper which is produced at the Shoalhaven Paper Mill for Passports and other uses when security takes priority over cost, or the range of Specialty Papers, for those printed items, when "Presentation," "Presentation," is called for, or the impact of the extensive range of Optix Coloured Paper, when you want to see the difference and if White Copy paper is required, then your choice to use Australian Reflex Copy Paper will also help to save another Australian Icon which was built in 1956 at Bomaderry NSW... I refer to the "Shoalhaven Paper Mill, which in 1974 had Three Paper Machines and over 1100 employees.*

*I know that many supporters who receive a copy of my newsletter, do not live in the Shoalhaven, but! I know that each and every one of you are concerned Citizens and what happens in one of our towns and villages, one day, can happen in all of our towns and villages.*

*The above link when you click on it will take you to a petition set up by the CFMEU and a letter of further explanation, from Jack Evans, who is the Nowra Sub Branch Secretary at the Shoalhaven Paper Mill. The petition is being sent to the Hon Barnaby Joyce MP to encourage him to rally the Federal Government to use more than the 12% of the present Australian Paper being purchased, of the 50 to 60 thousand tonnes of paper used annually by the Federal Government, before another Australian Icon company and Aussie jobs are lost to overseas imports...*

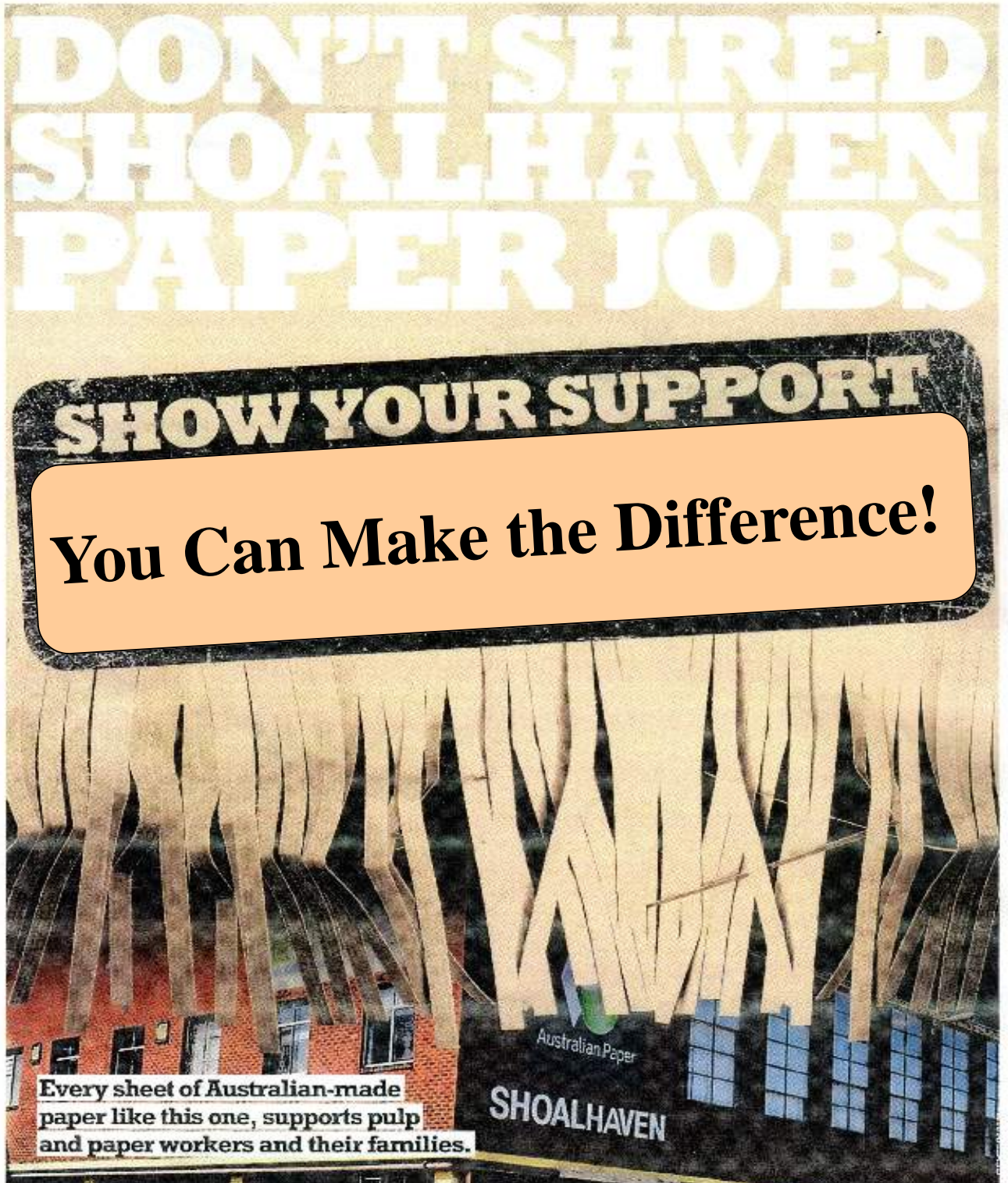
