These photos were taken on the 27th July 2018 and I dedicate them to the Men and Woman of our finest Police Force, who will report in to their new

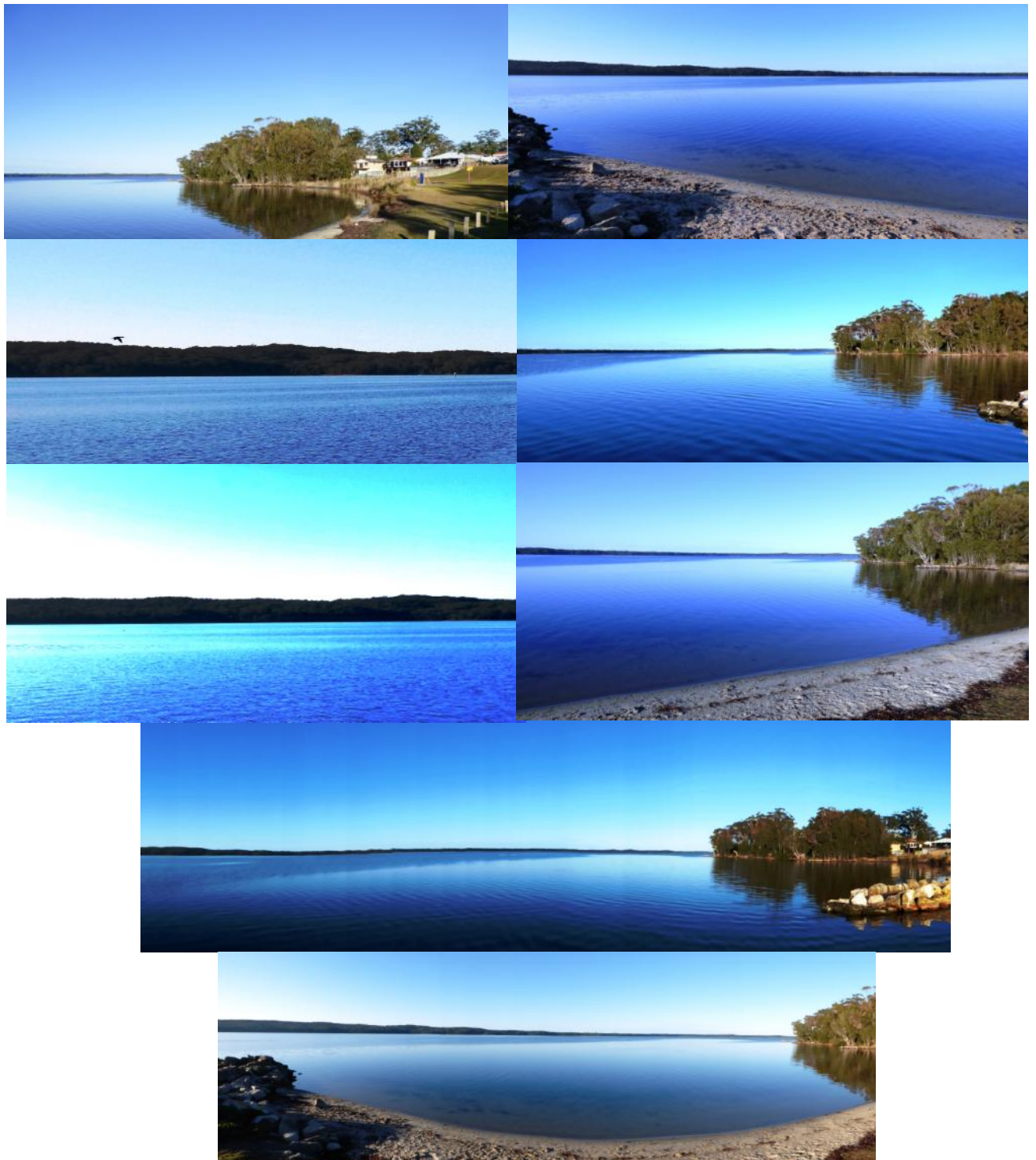
station and do what they do best... **KEEPING LAW AND ORDER** and **KEEPING US SAFE!!!**

RE: Delivering for the Bay and Basin

Over \$240,000 for the Paradise Beach Road and Kingsford Smith roundabout project was delivered by my Government under the Road Blackspot Program.

Over \$395,000 has also been secured for The Wool Road and Naval College Road to widen the lanes. This is part of over **\$240 million delivered for road improvements across the electorate.**

Recently, I announced **\$113,000 for the Sanctuary Point Child Care Centre.** This funding will help change the current layout of the Centre and Care service so more young children aged 0-2 can access the centre.

Voyager Park in Huskisson also received over \$600,000 to complete the Anzac and Voyager Memorial, upgrading the existing play equipment and finalising the entrance to the park.

With your help, we can work to secure more funding for Vincentia, Huskisson, Sanctuary Point, the Bay and Basin and Erowal Bay.

It's important to get funding for the Child Care Centre extension, but many residents have contacted me and suggested a **new library and education hub in Sanctuary Point would also be great for the local community.**

Nice to see someone had the sense to Provide a long footpath to the Toilet, for the construction of more when needed!!!

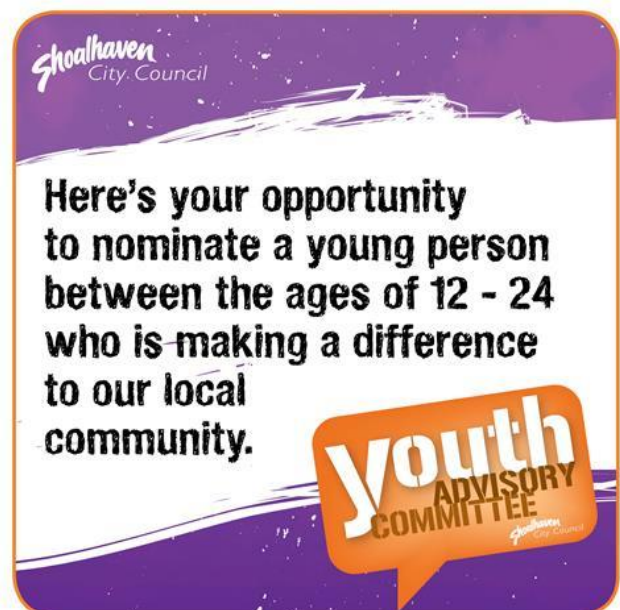
Regional Achievement and Community Awards

SCAMS:

A scam recently seen in the area involves purchases over the internet (no surprise). If you find a new item for sale on the internet at an incredibly low price think twice about it then forget it. If it's too good to be true, it normally isn't.

Picture this, you want to purchase an item over the internet. I will call you "A", the person selling an allegedly brand-new item to you for a very low price will be called "B" and a legitimate Company selling the same item that you require for the RRP which is double of what you are paying will be called "C". I will write this slowly so you can keep up.

"A" sends money to "B" via Bpay and gives "B" all relevant details such as delivery address, email address, phone number etc. "B" gets the money and keeps it. "B" places an internet order in relation to the exact same item that "A" requested to "C" and after using a dodgy credit card the order is delivered to "A". After the dust has settled, "A" has got the item. "B" Has got the money from "A" and "C" has no item and no money.

The Fraud is reported to Police and initial investigations seem to indicate that "A" is the offender by supplying false details to "C". However, because "A" kept copies of all transactions and other things such as receipts, web addresses and email addresses, "A" is discounted as the person of interest. After this the trail goes cold and "C" is the one that loses.

You must keep vigilant when surfing the World-Wide net. Don't become the subject of a future "On the beat".

Remember: Do not Drink and Drive and you can Dob in a Druggie any time you like, by contacting Nowra Police or ringing Crime Stoppers.

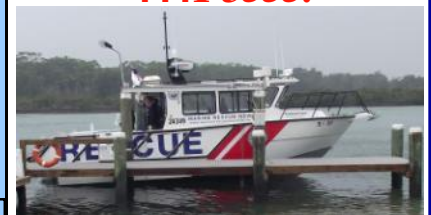
