Twinkling eyes will lose their lustre, on rosy cheeks a tear will fall, when sees a timid figure, crying against the darken wall.


He will gentle turn your door knob and your door will open wide and a Hi Ho Merry Christmas, will be echoing inside and a

\$450,000 to make Gilmore Streets Safer

Federal Member for Gilmore Ann Sudmalis is thrilled to confirm another election promise will be fulfilled, through the Safer Streets program.

Mrs Sudmalis said 'Four local areas have a great need for CCTV camera operations and they are Kiama, East Nowra, Bomaderry and Sanctuary Point'.

Mrs Sudmalis added 'this was an election promise that will be initiated July 2014'.

All up there was \$450,000 promised and funding will be made available for both Kiama and Shoalhaven Councils. The funding amounts are broken down to one project at Kiama worth \$150,000 and three projects each worth \$100,000 in East Nowra, Bomaderry and Sanctuary Point.

Mrs Sudmalis also said 'Crime Prevention is something we all think about in the community and this will go a long way to help NSW Police make our streets safer for all'.

Planning Assessment Commission approves Vincentia development

Shoalhaven City Council has welcomed the Planning Assessment Commission's (PAC) approval of the Vincentia Shopping Centre, subject to conditions.

The approval allows commencement of the planned \$80 million shopping centre which is set to contain retail stores Woolworths, Aldi and Big W while also allowing space for a Library at a later stage.

Mayor, Joanna Gash said the PAC decision to approve the project was an extremely positive outcome for the City.

"The \$80 million Vincentia Shopping Centre will provide tremendous benefit to the local area through both employment opportunities and an increase in retail shopping space," said Clr Gash.

"Council held several discussions with Woolworths and the Department of Planning prior to the approval and has made several submissions to ensure the approved modification was acceptable to the local community.

"A number of modifications were made to the final design as a result of recommendations from both Council and local residents."

"While this project has been the subject of a number of disruptions, I am extremely pleased to see it to a stage where construction can commence."

Mayor Gash said the Woolworths and Aldi supermarkets will be part of Stage One of the project while the commencement of the Big W and further speciality shops will be undertaken in Stage Two.

Stage Three of the project will consist of bulky goods, retail outlets and space for a Library.

Construction work is expected to commence in early 2014.
