

Council reminding residents to have their say on Community Infrastructure Strategic Plan survey

Shoalhaven City Council Mayor, Joanna Gash is reminding residents to have their say on the actions and priorities that will guide the organisations future funding and works programs.

Council is currently undertaking a major planning exercise through the creation of the Community Infrastructure Strategic Plan, a document designed to shape the Shoalhaven into a more vibrant and active community over the next 15 years.

Once completed, the Strategic Plan will make recommendations on the future provision, priorities and funding of community infrastructure at local, district and regional levels.

Mayor, Joanna Gash said Council was currently calling for local residents to have their say on existing recreational, sporting and community facilities through an online survey on the organisation's website.

The Mayor said it was important that Council received a cross section of views prior to the completion of the survey period on Friday 19 December 2014.

"Council has commissioned Ross Planning, Recreation Planning Specialists, to undertake a review of existing recreational, sporting and community facilities in the Shoalhaven," said Clr Gash.

"This information will be used in compiling the Community Infrastructure Strategic Plan, a document that will help set the organisations priorities and funding over the next 15 years.

"It is vitally important that all local residents who use the area's sporting fields, parks, libraries, walking tracks and aquatic services or listen to music, attend meetings and workshops or are part of a community group have their say through the specially devised online survey."

"This planning process is being undertaken to ensure the area will meet the many recreational needs of our community well into the future."

"I would certainly encourage all local residents to ensure they have their say on this vital planning document prior to the conclusion of the survey period on Friday 19 December 2014."

The Mayor said Council has previously undertaken a number of community forums as part of the current engagement process.

Mayor, Joanna Gash said following the current engagement process Council would be undertaking a community infrastructure audit and developing the draft plan. The community will be provided opportunity to make comment on the draft Community Infrastructure Strategic Plan in June 2015.

Police have continually advised the Public to lock their cars wherever they may park. The message is simple but there are still incidents occurring.
