Active Kids Program Letter to Parents/Guardians

Dear Parents,

Participation in sport is extremely valuable to our community. However, parents and families can at times find it difficult to meet the costs associated with their kid's participation sport.

That is why the NSW Government has announced the Active Kids Program designed to help parents with the financial costs of their kids participation. We want to make sport and fitness activities more affordable and get kids off the couch and active.

From 31 January 2018, parents will be able to **claim up to \$100 per school enrolled child per calendar year** as a voucher to reduce the cost of eligible sport and fitness activities.

These activities could include traditional sport such as netball, football or cricket; as well as other fitness or physical activities such as swimming classes or dance.

The rebate is not means tested so every family has access to this initiative. Parents will be able to register for the voucher online from 31 January 2018.

It was recommended that Council take immediate action to inhibit illegal camping on Red Head Villages beaches and reserves for the 2017-18 summer season. [Read more](#)

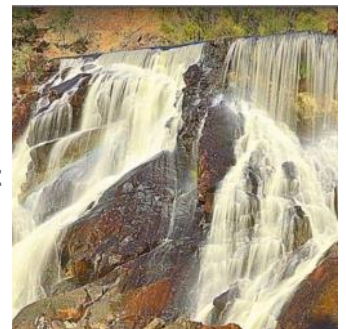


Danjera Dam Update

REPORT DANGEROUS DRIVING!

- Police have strong powers to prosecute drivers doing burnouts and street racing.
- Many Shoalhaven residents complain about these drivers but fail to provide enough information to police.
- Police can use your statement to identify and where appropriate prosecute these drivers.

WHAT TO DO:

- If you witness an offence call the police and report the incident while it's happening. Consider videoing or photographing the incident if you can.
- Phone Nowra Police station on 442 19099 or call the Police Assistance Line on 131444
- Carefully fill in the information on this sheet.
- Drop this form off to any Police station in person.

WHAT WILL HAPPEN:

- You will be contacted by Police to finalise your statement.
- The Police will interview the owner of the vehicle and where appropriate, prosecute the offender.
- Police may contact you at a later date to advise you of the outcome of proceedings.

Domestic and family violence

NSW Police know domestic and family violence is an abhorrent crime that damages our community at all levels and is related to approximately 40 per cent of all homicides.

Domestic violence does not discriminate. It impacts people of different genders, all ages and cultures. If you are in a domestic relationship and you are reading this then keep reading.

I cannot stress the importance of reporting any domestic violence incident to police.

Where there is evidence a domestic violence incident has occurred, is occurring, or is imminent, police will take action to ensure the victim and their family are afforded immediate protection.

The NSW Police Force Domestic and Family Violence Policy and the associated procedures provide strong and consistent responses directed at ensuring the safety and well being of victims; holding perpetrators to account and reducing risks to police safety. This means that if required, police will take out interim AVOs on your behalf. The perpetrator will be charged if there is enough evidence and put before a court at the soonest opportunity.

If a child has been abused, or is in need of protection from the offender, police will make an application for an AVO, investigate the matter, identify the offender and if the victim/s are still in danger, remove the offender from the house or sometimes the town.

Mark my words, if you are in any way prone to violence and cannot control your anger within the family unit, and you are the cause of a domestic violence incident, be warned. You will be spending time in the dock at Nowra Police Station and may well be eating prison food for some time if you touch your family in anger.

Remember: Do not Drink and Drive and you can Dob in a Druggie any time you like, by contacting Nowra Police or ringing Crime Stoppers.

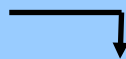

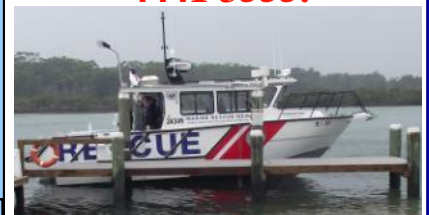
