When I first commenced this Newsletter in February 2011, Paul Green was the Mayor, but! It took a Federal Member of Parliament, the Honourable Joanna Gash MP... Federal Member for Gilmore to support my Newsletter as a community service and offered to print 300 of my Newsletter's each month! And to her word, 300 newsletter were printed and made ready for me to pick up from her Nowra Federal Office, each month from February 2011, until May 2012. Since June 2012 Kate and I took on the soul responsibility of printing all of the newsletters, that we distribute each month... Thank you Joanna Gash! Joanna is now the Mayor and also the Federal Member for Gilmore and I thought my life was complicated!

My second page opening words, of my first issue in February 2011, rightly deserves my first review in this my 24th Volume... "Because you are looking at the second page of this Newsletter, I take it that you are also, probably a little concerned, of what is happening in our Town. You most likely have the pride and dignity, that our town requires from its residents, and you also, would like to see our town return to its former glory, of the SANCTUARY it once was and from which it takes it's name ... SANCTUARY POINT." "If I had the visual pollution and potential dangerous hazards associated with my residential property, like that I encounter in my Town, I would be ashamed to call my home ... "Home!" So why would our Council... Shoalhaven Council, not be concerned enough to clean up their jurisdiction of Sanctuary Point, or have they also lost pride in their own jurisdiction... We all live in the Shoalhaven District and depend on our Council to represent its constituents in matters of blatant concern for the safety of our communities and everyone who live, visit, travel through, or comes in contact with our towns within the wonderful district of the SHOALHAVEN, need to trust our Local Council."

My initial focus was on the Graffiti, the state of the Pot Hole infested, shopping centre car parking, alongside of Paradise Beach Road. The untidy state of the rear side of the shops and the lack of maintenance of the path ways and roadways along the approach to and within Sanctuary Point.

Following Issues highlighted the half hearted attempt by Council Maintenance Department to cut the long overdue approach to Sanctuary Point. I introduced the disparity between the Entrance Signs.

Even the Signage on the Approaches, seem disproportionate!

Councillor Bob Proudfoot rallied the citizens of SANCTUARY POINT to assemble with our WORKING TOOLS, amongst the shabby result, left over, from the Shoalhaven Council's Maintenance Department.

There was a call for the establishment of a Sanctuary Point Community Pride Committee and there were Ten of the citizens attending a meeting, who nominated to join the committee, a motion was passed by Alan Blackshaw and the Sanctuary Point Community Pride Committee was duly passed! Councillors Watson, Proudfoot, Fergusson and Miller say! "They do have a care for what happens in SANCTUARY POINT!" Mayor Paul Green, has been privileged, with a seat in the State Upper House. He has also said that he will complete his Local Council Obligation ... Does that mean his SANCTUARY POINT obligations?

I addressed an issue towards the "YOUTH's" and "ADULT's," of Sanctuary Point... Where I asked, "What do you want? A District SKATE BOARD PARK, that Shoalhaven Council are bent on pushing on SANCTUARY POINT, or perhaps, would you prefer to have a District ... BMX BIKE PARK, with a MINI PUT, PUT, Golf Course, that all FAMILIES could enjoy and at half of the cost of the proposed \$445 Thousand Dollars, that our LOCAL SHOALHAVEN COUNCIL are prepared to give us, for another SKATE BOARD PARK.". I said! "We already have a Skate Park and we can see what has been done with that!! Council put that one in... COME ON!... Do we! or Council!... Tell us! what we want?? ... What Do You Want?? ... I Know what I would Prefer!! ... "\$445,000 Cleaning the mess in Sanctuary Point!"

I have kept you up to date with Richard (Dick) Manwarring's quest for his fund raising, for the Bay & Basin Cancer Support Group, Code C Fancy dress Nights, that would benefit The Shoalhaven Linear Accelerator and the Members of the Local Cancer Support Group, in their long roads to recovery from various forms of cancer!

In October 2011 The Sanctuary Point Volunteer Parkcare Group was formed and I was pleased to have been their inaugural Group Coordinator, until December 2012 when Robert Hitchcock was elected to the position.

These issues and many more issues, have been included in my Newsletter over the last twenty four months ... We have been given SUPPORT from our Federal and State Parliamentarians, our Local Council, the Police, the Local Business Owners, the Media and many of the Local Residents, who call our Town "Home". There has been some improvements around Sanctuary Point ... but! there is more ... much more to be done!

Graffiti is being challenged and in time CCTV cameras will be used to bring criminal perpetrators to account ... I have previously said that Australia's, clean up Graffiti bill is around \$80 –100 Million per year, or the cost of three hundred and thirty three, \$300,000 home and land packages, every year, that could be built and provided for those who are in need of Low cost housing! Give them the pride and dignity, that everyone in this great land deserver's! We have our Entrance Sign to Sanctuary Point, the shopping centre Car Park has been resealed, Graffiti is being removed around Sanctuary Point in a short time, Larmer Avenue and Centaur Avenue is being maintained more regularly by council and discussion papers are in progress, that will provide Sanctuary Point with a "Place Making action Plan," which can see our town prosper and develop over the next 20 years.

When you have the opportunity to have your say, on the development of our Town!... Will you stand up and be counted as a Concerned Citizen of Sanctuary Point?... Or will you let others decide for you?

## PREPARE. ACT. SURVIVE.

WAIT UNTIL THE FIRE IS ON TOP OF YOU AND YOU MAY DIE

#### PREPARE.

You must make important decisions before the fire season starts

You are at risk from bush fires if you live or work near bushland, grassland, scrub, or farmland.

A fire can be terrifying, with strong winds, intense heat and flames, and thick smoke. Don't make rushed and dangerous decisions. Prepare your Bush Fire Survival Plan. Relocate aged, young and sick family members early from areas likely to be impacted by fires. Leaving early is the safest option.

Your well-prepared home will increase the safety of fire fighters and is more likely to survive a bush fire even if you leave early.

#### ACT.

The higher the fire danger rating, the more dangerous the conditions

Know the fire danger in your area and what it means. The fire danger rating should be your first trigger for action and could save your life. When the rating is Catastrophic, leaving early is the only option for your survival.

Know your triggers. Be prepared to activate your Bush Fire Survival Plan with little or no warning.

#### SURVIVE.

Know what you will do to survive

Know your bush fire alerts.

Advice means a fire is nearby and you should stay up to date.

At Watch and Act, a bush fire is approaching and you need to put your Bush Fire Survival Plan into action.

An Emergency Warning means you may be in danger. Don't wait for direction from emergency services, as failure to act can result in death or injury.

If you plan to leave early, you should leave long before the bush fire is in your area. Do not stay and defend without careful planning and preparation.

Know an alternative route to a safer location. Find out if there is a Neighbourhood Safer Place in your area, but remember they should only be used as a place of last resort. Have a back-up plan in case you can't get to a safer location.

If it is an EMERGENCY ... call 000 and ask for Police.


