CLIFTON PARK SANCTUARY POINT

Clifton Park is one of the many well maintained recreational Parklands in Sanctuary Point. It consists of an area which contains children's Play equipment, then a narrow buffer of light flora, before continuing into the natural Parkland, where the local residents use for their own recreational walks and for exercising their dogs on leash, away from the non-existing footpaths and the many roadways in need of maintenance updates. To the southern end of the park, there is a creek, which is surrounded by and containing an abundance of Flora and Fauna and other forms of life such as Fungi. These plants, wildlife and the fungi, create their own diversified and beautiful worlds of natural wonders!

It has come to my attention, that Clifton Park is being introduced to the man made machines of high propulsion, petrol guzzling and exhaust explosive motor bikes and cars. Terror for both the flora and fauna and the local residents, who live nearby and are repeatedly subjected to the thoughtless behaviour of a minority of individuals, who constantly disobey Shoalhaven City Council's notice and conditions of Parkland use. The noise from these vehicles in the park, are mostly heard during the day and to-date, the rangers or police have not been able to deter them from the park. I was told that one person who spoke to me, was told by Nowra police, they were too busy to attend and was given the phone number of the Highway Patrol to call! They just gave up, for goodness sake, it is in a PARK, in the middle of a coastal village, not on the HIGHWAY! Obviously our General Duties Police are still grossly under staffed for the call outs they receive.

Update on long overdue sealed road for Residents Before



The quagmire which confronted these residents, adjacent to the overflow car park at Ray Brooks Reserve, formerly called Palm Beach, has now been addressed by council. It can be seen from these photos, the new road has been laid out, compacted and sealed with bitumen and has returned some Pride & Dignity to the residents, who have endured the unsealed access to their properties, for so many years.

Surely this could be considered a cul-de-sac and a turning circle included at the end of the access way? It would compliment the fine work that council has made and would earn council, the appreciation from

the resident rate payers, who really do not deserve the indignity from irate trucks and motorist having to reverse back out of this access way, not to mention the possibility of a vehicle reversing into the beach access road and colliding with enthusiastic beach users, arriving at the park.
