

The Honourable Shelley Hancock MP Speaker of the NSW Legislative Assembly Member for the South Coast in her June 2014 Newsletter, ran an article on "New Laws to Protect Property From Bushfires."

Mrs Hancock reported that South Coast residents will be given additional powers to protect their homes from bushfires, with new laws being introduced by the NSW Government to make it easier to clear trees and vegetation from around a property.

Under the proposed new laws people with homes in a bushfire zone will be able to clear trees within 10 metres of their house. They will also be able to clear shrubs and other vegetation, except for trees, within 50 metres of their house. The location of the designated bushfire zone areas - known as a '10/50 vegetation clearing entitlement area' - will be determined by the RFS.

I respectfully applaud any changes to the Law's of the land, where it may save lives and property of resident living in close proximity to our Australian rugged bushland, that may be determined - 'Bushfire Zone by the RFS,' But having recently been contacted by a resident, who lives in in such a property between 113 and 133 Tallyan Point Road, Basin View NSW 2540 who told me of his concern of

the build up of bush vegetation of trees, shrubs and leaves, decaying in the bush behind their property, where repeated calls to the Nowra Fire Brigade and Shoalhaven Council have only resulted in "we will look into it!"

I have recently made personal contact with this person and accompanied him on a rough walk through the area of concern. From my own experience of the surrounding bush and tall

timber, both living and dead wood, I took many photos and could only feel compassion towards the gentleman, his wife and family and their neighbours in the line of sight, should this area ever ignite and engulf their properties.

I have include a few of the photos I took on the day, on page 8 and 9 of this newsletter, but although a picture 'may tell a thousand words,' believe me, they do not express the sheer lack of maintenance and bush management that has, if ever; gone into this bush lands, so close to residential property, apart from the erection of the 'Welcome to Public Reserve,' signs.

Basin View like so many of the Villages of the Bay & Basin, is expanding in area and numbers and attracts its share of tourists for the Shoalhaven. It could attract a lot more, if a little more care was made in capitalising on pleasant bush walks and a good clean up of the rotting bush fuel, just waiting to erupt, with possible dire consequences. Please help protect their HOMES!
