Just last week the Turnbull Government's income tax relief passed the parliament, representing a huge win for the **58,134 working Australians in Gilmore**. This is your hard-earned money.

After seven years, the 37 cent tax bracket will be eliminated entirely, meaning 94% of taxpayers will pay no more than 32.5 cents in the dollar.

For workers, this means as your income increases over time, you will be protected from "bracket creep" and not pushed into higher tax brackets.

This month Gilmore was named as one of only ten regions across the country to receive **\$1 million** for a new locally based Employment Initiative fund.

The new Local Employment Initiative Fund will directly support jobs development through mentoring programs and the upskilling of people looking for work so that they are job ready.

For over five years, I have worked to deliver funding for the **new Nowra Bridge which is now** fully funded. This project will cut traffic congestion, create local jobs and improve safety on our roads in the Shoalhaven.

However, much more still needs to be done, and we can work together to secure further funding for the Princes Highway.

Some community suggestions have included the East Nowra Sub-Arterial, Jervis Bay Road Intersection, works at Wandandian, upgrades to Forest Road intersection and completion of Batemans Bay Link Road. Visit my website to nominate your priorities.

Through the Mobile Black Spot Program, East Lynne's new mobile phone base station has been switched on helping to improve phone reception.

This will make sure local residents and road users have access to a more reliable communication network especially in the event of an emergency.





Purchases over the Internet

A scam recently seen in the area involves purchases over the internet (no surprise). If you find a new item for sale on the internet at an incredibly low price think twice about it

then forget it. If it's too good to be true, it normally is.

Picture this, you want to purchase an item over the internet. I will call you "A", the person selling an allegedly brand-new item to you for a very low price will be called "B" and a legitimate company selling the same item that you require for the RRP which is double of what you are paying will be called "C".

I will write this slowly so you can keep up. "A" sends money to "B" via BPay and gives "B" all relevant details such as delivery address, email address, phone number etc. "B" gets the money and keeps it. "B" places an internet order in relation to the exact same item that "A" requested to "C" and after using a dodgy credit card the order is delivered to "A". After the dust has settled, "A" has got the item. "B" has got the money from "A" and "C" has no item and no money.

The fraud is reported to police and initial investigations seem to indicate that "A" is the offender by supplying false details to "C". However, because "A" kept copies of all transactions and other things such as receipts, web addresses and email addresses, "A" is discounted as the person of interest.

After this the trail goes cold and "C" is the one that loses. You must keep vigilant when surfing the world-wide net. Don't become the subject of a future "On The Beat".

Remember: Do not Drink and Drive and you can Dob in a Druggie any time you like, by contacting Nowra Police or ringing Crime Stoppers.
