- Sanctuary Point entrance signage is in progress ... Thank You!
- Goal Posts will be installed within two weeks, at the entrance to the Sanctuary Point shopping centre, off Paradise Beach Road, to stop heavy vehicles over 4 tonne entering the shoppers car park facilities ... Thank You!
- In 6 weeks, a new bitumen 6 tonne vehicle capacity, customer car park will be laid, to replace the dangerous and un-sightly pot holes that we have endured for too long ... Thank You!
- Graffiti is being challenged and in time CCTV cameras <u>will</u> be used to bring criminal perpetrators to account ... did you know that Australia's, clean up Graffiti bill is around \$80 –100 Million per year, or the cost of three hundred and thirty three, \$300,000 home and land packages, every year, that could be built and provided for those who are in need of Low cost housing! Give them the pride and dignity, that everyone in this great land deserver's and a chance to experience ... Thank You!
- The shoulder of roadways are being addressed and on going work should show further improvements around Sanctuary Point ... Thank You!

- The meeting attracted, about 100 concerned citizens.
- The new Police Area Commander for the Shoalhaven, Superintendent Wayne Murray was in attendance with his Inspector Kevin Henry, who both made themselves, very accessible to their audience and very open and direct with questions and answers ... Superintendent Murray is keen to work for and with the citizens of his command and will be assisting his officers, in the reduction of criminal activities in SANCTUARY POINT and the Shoalhaven at large ... Welcome Sir to your new COMMAND!
- There were three "Think Tanks" set-up and all in attendance split up into groups, that rotated around each of the Tables and contributed ideas, suggestions and thoughts on selected pre-selected categories;
 - 1. General Matters
 - 2. Police Matters
 - 3. Youth Matters

It was a time that Council and the Community worked together as one! And for a short time, all was good in Sanctuary Point.

• There was a call for the establishment of a Sanctuary Point Community Committee and there were Ten of the citizens attending, who nominated to join the committee, a motion was passed by Alan Blackshaw and was duly passed! ... Congratulations to each of the newly elected members, Kate and I wish you well with your newly formed committee.

For the NEGATIVES ...

- Once again, lack of publication of the meeting, resulted in a small attendance at a gathering, that should have meant so much, to so many of the citizens of Sanctuary Point ... but! They were not there ... Timing! Once again ... Dreadful!
- Kate and I delivered 100 personalised invitations, around Sanctuary Point, at our expense and emailed a further forty supporter's of our Newsletter. A further email was sent to dignitaries, who have helped to make changes to Sanctuary Point. It was nice to see the two wonderful members of our Federal and State Parliament ... Joanna Gash Federal MP for the electorate of Gilmore and Shelley Hancock State MP for the seat of the South Coast and Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, I also saw Councillor Greg Watson arrive, only to return to his car, to collect, a much needed, hand held microphone for the speakers. I was surprised that an Invitation from the organisers, was not sent to Shelley Hancock ... Come on! If we are serious about Crime in our Town ...
