2018 ANZAC Day

On the 25 April 2018 we gathered at the Australian National Memorial situated next to the Villers-Bretonneux Military Cemetery just north of the village of Villers-Bretonneux, France.

The Australian National Memorial is the site of an intense battle fought exactly 100 years before, as part of wider efforts to halt a German spring offensive which was threatening to win them the war.

Throughout early April, in 1918, Australian units helped defend Villers-Bretonneux from this onslaught, but at dawn on the 24th Germans attacked and captured the town.

Leading the British counter attack, the Australian 13 and 15 Brigades enveloped the town and successfully cleared it of Germans on 25 April, the third anniversary of the ANZAC landings at Gallipoli.

The Commemoration, on 25 April 2018, not only commemorates this remarkable action which effectively ended the German offensive launched a month prior but also marks the 103rd anniversary of the ANZAC landings at Gallipoli.

Council receives funding for upgrade of Duck Creek Bridge January 19, 2016

Shoalhaven City Council has been awarded \$750,000 in funding from the Member for Gilmore, Ann Sudmalis as part of the Federal Government's Bridges Renewal Program Round 2.



Council will be matching the funding with the total project cost of \$1.6 million. "The funding received from the Federal Member for Gilmore will allow for the timber bridge over Duck Creek on Naval College Road at Worrowing Heights to be replaced with a concrete bridge," said Cllr Gash.

**FOR INFORMATION:****Class 4 - Legal Challenge to Planning Proposal
PP0023****Class 1 - Appeal regarding Regional Development
Application RA17/1000**

Dear Residents,

The Land and Environment Court has listed Mr David DeBattista's action against Council challenging the Planning Proposal 0023 to reduce the building height of Mr DeBattista's land at St Georges Basin for hearing in Sydney on **26, 27 and 28 September 2018**.

This is classified by the Court as a Class 4 proceeding. It is not the practice of the Court to permit resident submissions in Class 4 proceedings. If you are interested in the Court's general procedure for Class 4 matters you may access the Practice Note by clicking on the following link: [Practice Note - Class 4 Proceedings \(PDF\)](#)

The Court has also listed the Class 1 Appeal concerning Mr DeBattista's regional development application (RA17/1000 - Masterplan for 15 multi storey buildings) for hearing in Sydney on **27, 28 and 29 November 2018**.

Unlike Class 4 proceedings, it is the usual practice of the Court to permit resident submissions on site on the morning of the first day of the hearing. The Court has not made any direction with respect to the resident submissions. In this case, the Court may decide to rely upon the residents' submissions provided at the section 34 Conciliation Conference, particularly if the same Commissioner is appointed to preside over the hearing.

Council's legal team for both actions include Mr Andrew Pickles of Senior Counsel; and Alan Bradbury and Andrew Brickhill from BAL Lawyers.

Council representatives will be in touch with the community representatives closer to the hearing date to discuss the Court's directions regarding resident submissions.

An update on the promise by The Hon. Shelley Hancock MP for a new Ambulance Station for the Bay & Basin being fulfilled.

In December 2017, the first sod was turned on the construction of the new Bay & Basin NSW Ambulance station.



The sod turn marked the beginning of main works on the station which is scheduled for construction completion by late 2018, followed by a carefully managed fit-out and operational commissioning phase before paramedics transition into the facility.

Once completed, the new NSW Ambulance station will include:

- **Parking bays for up to four ambulance vehicles to ensure our infrastructure is ready to meet projected patient demand increases over the next decade and beyond**
- **Administration and office areas**
- **Amenities**
- **Logistics and storage areas**
- **Training / meeting room**
- **Relief accommodation**
- **External vehicle wash bay**
- **On site staff parking**

Cover Your Load

Uncovered waste loads impact directly on other road users and the environment.

Uncovered loads of waste can spill onto the road and cause safety issues. Dust, soil and litter that escape from vehicles can wash into stormwater drains and pollute waterways.

Always transport waste, securely covered to a lawful place.



Vehicles transporting uncovered waste loads can incur a fine of over \$250 (for individuals), \$1500 for a company plus loss of demerit points.

What do you do with the old junk in the spare room or the surplus materials out in the shed. You could take it to the tip or have a garage sale or you could even sell your unwanted items on the Internet.

I myself have never sold anything on the internet as apparently you have to be connected to the internet and also own a device that is compatible. If anyone says, "I am having trouble getting on to "Pay Pal" or some other questionable excuse why they can't pay at the time of the sale be very careful. If you think that something is fishy it most likely is.

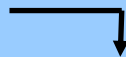

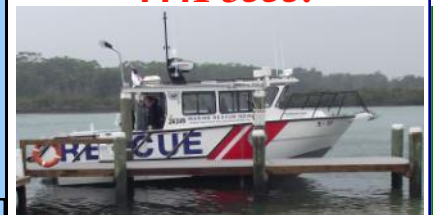
