

A re-elected Baird Government would construct a new Police Station in the Bay & Basin. The current Police station at Huskisson, after 35 years of service, will be relocated to a new site. A location near the present Crossroads Rural Fire Service at Vincentia is high on the list, although other areas will be considered.
