Day 1 START OF THE SHOALHAVEN CANCER CARE CENTRE.

Construction work commenced on the 26th March 2012 for the Cancer Care







Centre and Car Park, which will become the home of the SHOALHAVEN LIN-EAR ACCELERATOR.

The effects from cancer, at some time, will usually affect us all, if not from cancer itself, then from the attachment we have with someone we know with cancer.

In our local area, the Bay and Basin **Cancer Support Group members know** of the additional strain put on themselves and their love ones as they are compelled to travel the long road to Wollongong or even Sydney where their life given treatment is administered by the caring Oncology and Radiotherapy staff at these wonderful Cancer Care Centres. It must be a blessing for those, and so many other cancer patients, throughout the Shoalhaven and surrounding districts, to know that in the near future, their long road for treatment will be made much shorter, when the Shoalhaven Centre is commissioned and treatment commences in Nowra.

Mr Richard (Dick) Manwarring, who is the Coordinator for the fund raising events of the Code C Benefit nights and his dedicated support team, are on track to raise over \$45,000 for the Bay & Basin Cancer Support Group, who will provide two quiet rooms at the new Cancer Centre, one for the Oncology and one for the Radiotherapy Departments. The third Benefit night will take place at the St Georges Basin Country Club, in Sanctuary Point on the 6th October 2012.
