City Council Upper Kangaroo River Road and Upper Kangaroo River - Landslip

Upper Kangaroo River Road was severely impacted by the March East Coast Low and subsequent rain events.

With high rainfall predicted, Council staff will be actively inspecting road conditions on the weekend. This is consistent with the adopted Trigger Action Response Plan to ascertain the stability of roads & the need for temporary road closures.

Project Updates - Major Landslip Repairs

17/4/23 - Due to delays in the procurement and delivery of special hot rolled steel channel product from South Australia, the commencement date for landslip repair work along Upper Kangaroo River Rd will be delayed by two weeks. Repair work will now commence on Monday 1st May. Completion date for Upper Kangaroo River Rd and the proposed commencement dates on all other roads remain unchanged.

About the project

The July 2022 east coast low natural disaster event brought with it torrential rain, damaging winds and floods that resulted in widespread landslips, road damage and isolation for some in our community.

The Shoalhaven community showed incredible resilience again following the March 2022 natural disaster event that brought more heavy and sustained rainfall that caused further widespread damage to our public infrastructure and impacted many in our community.

The September 2022 severe weather and floods was also declared natural disaster but mainly caused widespread damage to communities in western NSW. This same weather event also impacted the Shoalhaven LGA although the damage to our infrastructure and the impacts to our community this time was much milder.



Free workshops help residents to flip the switch to electric.

Residents are being encouraged to electrify their homes and reap the benefits of clean energy as part of a campaign delivered by local councils across Australia.

Throughout May, Council is hosting free community workshops in Nowra and Ulladulla to help people save energy and reduce carbon emissions as part of the Electrify Everything initiative.

Mayor Amanda Findley said the campaign will shine a light on the range of benefits of going electric and the options available to locals to make the switch.

"All-electric is better for your hip pocket, better for the environment and the healthiest option for your home and family," Cr Findley said.

"Any step towards clean energy makes an impact and there are steps you can take as a renter or homeowner, a young family or a retired couple," she said.

Some of the options available include installing energy-efficient reverse-cycle air conditioning, switching to an electric hot water heat pump, choosing an electric bike or vehicle and installing solar panels. "There are a number of funding opportunities available right now that our community can take advantage of, and whether it takes six months or six

years, we are helping our residents to plan to make the switch." Residents can find out more about the Electrify Everything movement, download a checklist, or sign up to one of the free workshops by visiting the <u>Shoalhaven City Council</u> website.

Shoalhaven City Council has joined with 60 councils from across Australia to promote the benefits of converting away from using gas for heating and cooking, petrol and diesel vehicles and electricity generated by coal-fired power stations.



Boardwalk Construction Ray Brooks Reserve Sanctuary Point Update. Last reviewed 24 April 2023

About the project... The project involves the replacement of the existing boardwalk, including demolition, construction, and associated concrete works.



The boardwalk project commenced in 2022 with the removal of the existing dilapidated access boardwalk which had come to end of life.

Due to unforeseen, prolonged weather events, and extended material lead times, the construction program has experienced significant delays. It is now anticipated the project will be open to the public by July 2023 and will provide wheelchair accessible access into this much loved reserve which will compliment other accessible features including amenities, BBQs and other park infrastructure.

During this time vehicle access to the reserve will remain unrestricted, however pedestrian access to the reserve, in close proximity to the construction site, will be closed. Pedestrians are advised to access the reserve via the walkway between 216-218 Greville Avenue Sanctuary Point. Council has provided directional signage indicating alternative pedestrian access to the reserve.




