The program is for school year 6 - 12 youth and will now be held at the Sanctuary Point Youth & Community Centre, at 34 Paradise Beach Road, Sanctuary Point, from 6.00 pm to 8.30 pm every Friday night, except school holidays. On the last Friday of each month, a bus will be sent out to the Sanctuary Point Youth & Community Centre that will pick up youth from the Community Centre entrance at 5.30 pm and return there at 9.30 pm, to bring youth into the Nowra Campus for a massive combined night. The bus will cost \$2 return and Parent or guardians permission will be required on a form to be supplied, for anyone using the bus. This is a fully supervised program with adult security and it is drug and alcohol free. # Shoalhaven Council is serious, in their commitment to

Eliminate Graffiti from the Shoalhaven! ... Apart from Graffiti Day now being incorporated with Clean-up Australia day, when the community gets together with Council to clean-up rubbish and Graffiti, around and upon Council Assets, Graffiti is illegal and comes under the Graffiti Control Act 2008, which is being amended with the Graffiti Control Amendment Bill 2011 that introduces some very strong sentencing when caught illegally placing Graffiti on public or private property.

In a speech in the NSW State Parliament Legislative Council on the 10th August 2011 the Minister for Police and Emergency services, had this and other comments to say about the amendment Bill.

#### GRAFFITI LEGISLATION AMENDMENT BILL 2011 Second Reading 10th Aug 2011

The Hon. MICHAEL GALLACHER: (Minister for Police and Emergency Services, Minister for the Hunter, and Vice-President of the Executive Council) [4.15 p.m.]: Government members are excited about this legislation. I thank them for their support for this important piece of legislation. It sends a message to young offenders that we are serious about assisting them in breaking the cycle of offending. For many young people, graffiti vandalism is the starting point of offending. The approach taken by the previous Government led to many young offenders being in a never-ending cycle of cautions and warnings and incrementally working their way through to committing more serious crimes. Under this legislation they will be appear before a court so that they understand that the community and the Parliament view graffiti vandalism as a serious crime. We also have ensured follow-up measures. As young offenders clean up their own mess or the mess of others they will get a clear signal that the community will not tolerate this crime any further. The community has had enough.

One resident of Sanctuary Point, told me of his suggestion to Councillor Bob Proudfoot, that a light should be put in place to shine down on the new Sanctuary Point Entrance Signage, as being done at Vincentia ... I fully support that endorsement and would recommend that it be kept in vogue, with Solar Power and perhaps the placement of a CCTV as an introduction to our town Sanctuary Point.
