

The latest employment data show's that youth unemployment has halved in the Shoalhaven and Southern Highlands (the ABS join the Shoalhaven and Southern Highlands together) since the introduction of the \$20 million Regional Jobs Investment Package, the Youth Jobs PaTH program, the Gilmore Apprenticeship Challenge, the Local Employment Initiative Fund and hosting a series of employment forums, my commitment to getting more people into work has delivered real results.

Youth employment now sits at 85.9%, up from 70.7% this time last year, and our general employment is now at 92.2%.

We have seen an increase of over 3.8% in the total number of apprentices undertaking training when compared to data in 2017.

In July of this year the economy created 19,300 full-time jobs. The Government will continue to strive to increase employment in Australia.



You duck down a side alley which has no pedestrian traffic or proper lighting. The footsteps behind you are getting louder and seem to be getting faster, you want to run but your arthritis won't allow it. You know there is a lot of money in your bag, you need it to pay rent. What would you do without it? How will you survive the week?, what will happen if you get robbed? At this point it would be fair to say that you are feeling more than anxious. But the scenario does not need to play out as long as you are aware of some simple points such as;

PERSONAL SAFETY

*Keep cash and valuables to a minimum. * Always keep your personal belongings close to your body and never leave them unattended. * If someone does attempt to take your property, don't resist. * Have your keys ready before you get to your home or car. * Be aware of your surroundings.

BANKING

Vary the routine of your banking: days, times and branches. * Protect your password and PIN. * Don't display cash in public. * Never carry large sums of money.
